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Lifting The Spirits Again

As well as lifting spirits at their recent Leicester Cathedral appearance, even more uplifting was the Men United Reunion concert in Bingham this June at the Bingham Methodist Church. Many of the original volunteers from the 2024 Prostate Cancer singing project (Men United) met up with their fellow volunteers who had gone on to join the Radcliffe On Trent Male Voice Choir. Once again the choir revelled in singing their original repertoire, with a few new numbers thrown in. These were sensitively supported by Tabitha Kumar on Flute and Jo Bennett on Violin, each a musical daughter of one of the music team and a choir member. Along the way, the audience heard light-hearted interviews with the music team and choir members who joined the project and who survived Prostate Cancer PLUS a reminder to all men to request a PSA blood test from their GP. As a finale, the choir provided a “surround sound” experience where they performed in the round, encircling the audience with a performance of the iconic song “The Rose”. This was the song the volunteers learned in their first session, surprising the music team by how well and how harmoniously they sang after just 2 hours training. Once again, the choir earned a standing ovation and once again, the audience generously donated to the bucket collections more than £1,000 for Prostate Cancer UK.
