The Radcliffe on Trent Male Voice Choir is not standing still this year, even after an intensive and successful project to support Prostate Cancer UK by recruiting 100 volunteers to sing and perform – many who had not sung nor performed at all. From the enthusiastic sell-out debut performance at Southwell Minster, they went on to perform in a massed choir event at Nottingham's Albert Hall and a "farewell" free concert at West Bridgford's St Giles Church (squeezing in a Flashmob at The Victoria Shopping Centre).

With their new recruits, the choir hit the road at Woodthorpe's Church of the Good Shepherd and was then privileged to sing at the Parachute Regiment's 80th Memorial concert at Melton Mowbray's St Mary's Church.

After taking in a Shropshire tour, where they sang at Shrewsbury Abbey and the Ironbridge Victorian, then back home they stood still – but just for a minute! For a photo with Robert Oldroyd, Nottingham Prostate Cancer Support Group representative, who received a cheque for £60,000 (with another £500 to be added to that and donations still rising).

Finally, rehearsals are underway for TWO Christmas concerts; in Bingham Arena on Friday 13th December at 2.00pm and then on 21st December at 2.30pm in St Mary's Church Radcliffe on Trent. Both concerts feature guest musicians and a children's choir and are supporting Childline.

Then the choir will be still for a well-earned rest, but not for long as the 2025 repertoire will be introduced and off we go again!
